**Volunteer Role Description:** Field Photographer/Videographer

**Position Overview:** We are seeking dedicated individuals with a passion for photography and/or videography to join our volunteer team as Field Photographers/Videographers. In this role, you will have the unique opportunity to document significant environmental events and issues across the state of Florida. Your visual storytelling skills will play a crucial role in raising awareness about environmental conservation efforts.

**Duties:**

- Capture high-quality photographs and videos of environmental events and issues, landscapes, wildlife, and other events related to the Florida Wildlife Federation.
- Edit and enhance photos and videos to create compelling visual narratives.
- Collaborate with other volunteers and staff to ensure comprehensive coverage of events and issues.
- Assist Digital Communications Manager to design content to boost engagement, educate, and inform FWF followers on social media.
- Participate in scheduled check-ins with Manager

**Qualifications:**

- Proficient in photography and videography techniques, with a portfolio demonstrating strong visual storytelling skills.

- Knowledgeable about environmental issues and conservation efforts, particularly in the state of Florida.
- Willing to travel to various locations within Florida (travel distance is voluntary and based on personal availability).
- Able to work independently and collaboratively in dynamic environments.
- Owns and is proficient with necessary photography/videography equipment.

**Impact of the role:**

- Use your photos and videos to contribute to environmental advocacy and conservation efforts.
- Support our efforts to inspire Floridians to organize and act at the local, state and national level to accomplish positive change and conserve Florida's wildlife and natural resources.
- Gain valuable experience in documenting environmental events and issues while building a diverse portfolio showcasing your photography and videography skills.
- Network and collaborate with like-minded individuals passionate about the environment.

**Supervision:** You will report to the Education and Outreach Coordinator, who will be responsible for your training and scheduling, and work with the Digital Communications Manager to see which issues need coverage.

**Training opportunities:** An online training will provide information on the work of our organization, how to respond to FAQ's and refer questions to staff. Meetings with Education and Outreach Coordinator and Digital Communications Manager will provide additional training

**Time Commitment:** At least 1 project a year is recommended.
